



We stock a complete line of lawn & turf products for home owners who want to surround their home with a beautiful lawn. When used as a four-step all season program, this approach will furnish the nutrients and pest control required for growing healthy grass, and looking the very best throughout the growing season.

1. Spring or Fall: Apply **Lime** per soil test recommendations using pelletized dust-free, fast acting pellets of ground limestone, which reduces acidity and helps grass use fertilizer more efficiently. (50 lb. bag covers 1,000-1,200 square feet.)
2. Late March-Mid April: Apply **Crabgrass preventer 2G** at 2-3 lb. per 1,000 square feet for crabgrass control. It should be applied while the forsythia is blooming. (40 lb. bag covers 13,000-16,000 square feet) or use **Green Yard Crabgrass Preventer 15-0-5 with .37% Cavalcade** for both broadleaf & crabgrass weed control. (50 lb. bag will cover 8,000-12,000 square feet.)

OR

Late April-Mid May: Use **Green Yard Weed & Feed 15-0-5 Fertilizer with Trimec Broadleaf Herbicide** for broadleaf weed control at 5 lb. per 1,000 square feet. Apply as the dandelion begins to bloom in the spring. (50 lb. bag will cover 10,000-12,500 square feet) The grass must be damp from dew or rain for the best weed control results.

3. June - July: Use **Criterion .5G Insecticide** at 1.5-1.8 lb. per 1,000 square feet depending upon insect infestation. It is an excellent white grub and Masked chafer control! Apply if a problem exists. (30 lb. bag covers 16,000-20,000 square feet) It should be watered within 7-10 days with a minimum of ½" rain.
4. August-September: Fertilize using **10-9-20 11% Fe** at 3.5-4.5 lb. per 1,000 square feet. (50 lb. covers 14,000 square feet) or use treatment #3 if broadleaf weeds are present.
